



24 Street SE Storm Pond and Ogden Landfill Remediation

Project Background

The City of Calgary is building a new dry storm pond and completing the construction of an embankment that will be part of the corridor for the future Green Line LRT. The pond and embankment are being built on the west half of the former Ogden Dry Waste Management Facility. This is a complex project that requires 24/7 activity at the worksite. Most of the work is expected to be completed by the end of December 2020. Minor surface work will take place in the spring of 2021.

Morgan Construction and Environmental Ltd. is the prime contractor hired by The City to complete the project.

What we did in September



Working at night, September 2020

We continue to enjoy surprisingly good weather conditions. That has allowed us to accomplish:

- ✓ Activated night construction shift to speed up completion of the project;
- ✓ Continued pumping and treatment ground water. Pumping needs have declined as the project advances;

- ✓ Hauled out of the site over 3,000 truckloads of contaminated soils and garbage for proper disposal at a City landfill.
- ✓ Brought in over 5,000 truckloads of clean fill to build the embankment for the future Green Line LRT;
- ✓ Provided emergency support to the South Hill Mobile Homes Park to fight a fire in the community.

What to expect in October

- ✓ Groundwater pumping and treatment will continue, but at slower pace. Night treatment will likely be reduced or even eliminated;
- ✓ The night construction shift will remain active for the month of October;
- ✓ Now that most of the waste within the work site has been removed, we will be able to focus on completing the embankment and continue progressing with the pond;
- ✓ The installation of a large structure related to the pond may affect temporarily the use of sidewalk on the east side of 24 St SE north of 91 AV SE.

As the project advances, there will be noise, dust and lighting typical of construction of this nature. We will continue monitoring possible issues and take corrective actions to keep disturbances at reasonable levels.
