



Woodbine Lift Station upgrades

September 2023

Background

Lift stations are one of the critical pieces of infrastructure we use to help move wastewater from your community to one of The City's wastewater treatment plants.

The Woodbine Lift Station Upgrade project will extend the expected service life of the lift station and help us to continue to provide reliable wastewater service in your community.

Last summer, we completed the first phase of the project which consisted of exterior work and landscaping improvements. Starting this September, we'll be completing the more substantial electrical upgrades to the internal systems inside the building.

Schedule of work

Work is scheduled to begin **September 11** and is expected to be completed by late 2023.

Construction impacts

- Chandos Construction personnel working on site will be parking along the green space on the east side of Woodacres Drive S.W., south of the construction site at 79 Woodacres Drive S.W., Monday to Friday during daytime construction hours (i.e., between sunrise and sunset).
- Deliveries of materials and equipment to the construction site could cause minor traffic delays but will not require any formal detours or road closures.

- Construction related noise will be present during the project but will be compliant with the Community Standards Bylaw.
- Access to the Canada Post Community Mailbox will always remain open.
