

Glenmore Trail Feedermain Upgrade

July 2021

The City of Calgary continues to treat, test and deliver high-quality water to Calgarians during the COVID-19 pandemic. While we prioritize the delivery of essential services, our capital construction programs are moving forward where possible. These projects are critical to supporting current and future development. We're working closely with our partners and will continue to monitor the current situation, making adjustments as needed.

Our most important priority remains the health, safety and well-being of citizens, staff and contractors. We continue to put in place new measures and protocols to ensure public health is always protected.

Background

The Glenmore Trail & 11 St. SE. Feedermain project will see an upgrade to the existing water supply line along the south side of Glenmore Trail.

We do not anticipate any disruptions to the water service supply for the duration of this project.

Project Timeline

Construction is planned to begin late July and be completed this fall 2021.

Project details

- The contractor, Whissell Contracting Ltd., will be working to install approximately 130 meters of new water supply line in the existing grass section north of the Leon's parking lot during late July and August.
- Access to the site will be accessed off 11th St. SE.

- This work also requires the construction of a new valve chamber to allow for future inspection and maintenance of the feedermain.
- This work will take place from late August through September 2021 and involves removing an old valve chamber adjacent to the Glenmore Trail and Deerfoot Trail southbound exit ramp.
- This work will be completed via access along the Trail Appliances' north parking lot.

Construction impacts

- Speed reduction for traffic along 11th St SE. during construction hours with all lanes operational except for a short duration in early September with single lane traffic to allow for the new water supply line connection.
- Possible speed reduction on the Glenmore Trail east bound Deerfoot south exit.
- Increased noise relating to heavy equipment operations during work times from 7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.
- We do not anticipate any disruptions to the water service supply.
