



Marlborough Dry Pond Repair

October 2021

To reduce the risk of flooding in your community and to protect the health of the rivers, we will be repairing the damaged structures in the Marlborough dry stormwater pond.

Background

In summer 2021, an extreme rainfall event damaged the pond's underground infrastructure that collects and retains stormwater from the streets in your community and gradually releases it to the rivers. The structures need to be repaired to ensure public safety and the pond functions as intended.

Timeline and scope

The project will begin in late October and is anticipated to be completed in mid-November 2021 (weather dependent).

As part of the work, the manhole covers will be adjusted and aligned with the barrels, collapsed ground will be restored, reseeded or asphalted.

Additional minor repairs around the pond will be undertaken as needed.

Construction impacts

- During construction, residents can expect to see trucks and equipment entering and leaving the pond area. There will be some excavations and small piles of soil.
- Fencing around the damaged structures and signage will be installed to ensure public safety, but the parking lot and pathway will remain open.
- The work will comply with the Community Standards Bylaw with respect to hours of operation and noise limits.
