

Local Drainage Improvements – 7409 22 St SE

To reduce the risk of flooding in your community, we will be installing a new catch basin and stormwater pipe from December 3rd to December 11th.

While we continue to treat, test and deliver high quality water to Calgarians during the COVID-19 pandemic, our capital construction programs are moving forward where possible. These construction projects are critical to supporting current and future development while also protecting our environment.

As with all capital projects, our priority is the health, safety and well-being of citizens, staff and contractors. We continue to monitor and when required, put in place new measures and protocols to ensure public health is always protected.

Background

To alleviate localized flooding along 22 Street SE between 74 Avenue and 76 Avenue SE, the City is upgrading existing infrastructure.

This project is part of the Local Drainage Improvements (LDI) program, which is an initiative that aims to better manage stormwater and/or run-off in smaller areas like alleyways. LDI projects include the construction of a new storm drain or catch basin.

Project details

- The contractor for this project is Volker Stevin.
- Crews will install a 161 metre pipe and new catch basin to connect to the existing stormwater system. When this work is complete, crews will pave a portion of the back alley in spring 2021.

Construction Impacts

- Road closures will be required along back alley to accommodate the work. Traffic accommodations and detours will be in place.
- Residents will not have access to the lane during construction
- Underground work will begin December 3rd and is expected to be complete by December 11th.
- Noise and dust impacts will be monitored to fall within bylaw limits.
- Work hours are Monday to Saturday from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.
- For safety, the work site will be fenced, and access will be restricted to construction personnel only.
- Waste and recycling bin collection will be moved from the back alley to 22 Street SE.
