

# Deer Run Local Drainage Improvement Project: landscaping

April 2022

## Background

During large rainfall events, homes in Deer River Circle S.E. experienced flooding originating from a manhole in the Queensland Off Leash Area. To fix this, we built a concrete retaining wall to divert flooding away from these homes.

Following construction, we tried to landscape the area, however the seed that was planted did not take due to the high volume of pedestrian and vehicle traffic.

We are making another effort to restore this area. This will involve reseeding, installing an irrigation network and protecting this area with a fence to allow the seed time to establish.

## Project timeline

Seeding and installation of the temporary irrigation network and fence is expected to begin April 25 and take approximately a week to complete. The fence will remain in place for six months to give the grass seed time to establish without interference.

## Project impacts

- The paved path connecting Deer River Circle S.E. and the Queensland Off Leash Dog Park will be closed for six months. The detour will be via Deer River Gate S.E.
- Access for service vehicles needing to access the north end of the green space will be via Fish Creek Park.
- Detour information will be posted onsite.
