



# Local drainage improvement project

September 2021

The City of Calgary would like to share information on an upcoming drainage improvement project in your area.

## Background

To alleviate localized flooding in your area, upgrades are required to existing stormwater infrastructure.

This project has been identified as part of our *Localized Drainage Improvement (LDI) Program*, which is an initiative that aims to better manage stormwater and/or run-off in smaller, limited areas. It entails the construction of a new storm watermain, catchbasins and/or re-grading.

## Project details

- Professional Excavators will be the prime contractor for this project.
- Surface regrading will take place along 19 Ave SW between 32 and 33 Street SW.
- Installation of underground storm line along 31 Street SW between 17 and 19 Ave SW.
- Scheduled start date is September 20, 2021 and is expected to take 3-4 weeks to complete.

## Construction impacts

- Road closures will be required along 31 street between 17 and 19 Ave and along 19 Ave between 32 and 33 Street. Sidewalk access will be limited within these closures. Detours will be in place if local access is required. We understand the inconvenience and crews will be working as fast as possible to re-open sidewalks

- Mobilization/Lay down areas for construction equipment will be within Killarney Aquatics Center parking lot
- Noise and dust impacts will be monitored to fall within bylaw limits.
- Work hours are 7am-7pm; however, there may be times where operations will occur after 7pm when traffic volumes are lessened.
- For safety, the work site will be fenced, and access will be restricted to construction personnel only.

## Work during the COVID-19 pandemic

While we continue to treat, test and deliver high-quality water to Calgarians during the COVID-19 pandemic, our capital construction programs are moving forward where possible. These construction projects are critical to supporting current and future development while also protecting our environment.

As with all capital projects, our priority is the health, safety and well-being of citizens, staff and contractors. We continue to monitor and when required, put in place new measures and protocols to ensure public health is always protected.
