



Drainage Improvements – Elveden Dr. S.W.

Spring 2021

Background

To prevent stormwater from spilling into the properties on Elmont View S.W. during extreme rain events, The City has contracted Year Round Landscaping to upgrade the existing storm infrastructure.

This work is a result of a request from area residents and will benefit residents of Elmont Green, as well as local commuters and pedestrians.

Construction details

- Construction is scheduled to start early May will take approximately four weeks.
- An earthen berm will be built on Elveden Drive S.W. from the top of the pedestrian staircase and to the north, adjacent to the existing sidewalk for approximately 45 m.
- A new concrete culvert will be installed at the top of the stairs and will be connected to a new grass swale as well as curb and gutter, directing overland drainage to the existing stormwater network.

Construction impacts

- There may be temporary lane closures on Elveden Drive S.W.
- The stairway from Elveden Drive S.W. through to Elveden View S.W. will be closed for the duration of construction. Pedestrian detour signs will be placed in the area. See reverse for detour map.
- For the safety of the workers onsite we may need to remove two or three trees. The trees are located on private property and we are working directly with the property owner.
- For site safety and security, the work site will be fenced and access will be restricted to construction personnel only. Please keep children and pets away from the work area.

- There will be an increase of construction traffic/vehicles, equipment and noise throughout the duration of the project. Standard work days will be Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., weather dependent.

Work during the COVID-19 pandemic
