

Priddis Slough South Outfall

March 2021

To improve the existing drainage of the community and support the future development, we will be installing a storm trunk on the west side of Macleod Trail from March until September 2021.

Project background

This project will support residential development within south Calgary by providing new stormwater infrastructure for the future west Macleod area development. A PVC storm pipe will be installed on the west side of the Macleod Trail connecting the Priddis Slough and Pine Creek Outfall. This storm pipe will allow The City to use Priddis Slough as a stormwater management facility and control the natural water level there.

Project timeline

The project will begin mid-March and is expected to be completed by the end of September 2021 (weatherdependent.)

What to Expect

- The contractor will mobilize to the site in mid-March.
- Deep excavation will be required to install the storm pipe and the contractor may have to pump out the groundwater. All groundwater will be treated before being discharged in compliance with City bylaws.
- Fencing and signs will be placed around the construction zone for safety.
- There may be some construction noises and dust noticeable during the day. Provisions will be in places to keep the noise and dust disturbance to reasonable levels. The work will comply with the Community Standards Bylaw with respect to hours of operation and noise limits.
- There may be short term lane closures and restriction throughout construction but access to businesses will be maintained at all times.
