


Riparian Activity Book



Welcome to the Riparian Zone

Did you know?

The word riparian (pronounced **ri·peh·ree·uhn**) comes from the Latin word "ripa", meaning bank or shore and refers to the lands beside a water body.

Riparian areas unfold like ribbons across our watershed, including landscapes where land and water meet. They border rivers, creeks and wetlands.

Which of these creatures do you think is fastest on land? On water? In the air?






Take a walk along one of Calgary's rivers or creeks and complete the following activities:

Check which of these riparian plants you see 🗹






Keep your eye on the water


