Construction Update:

February 10, 2025 – end of March 2025

- Sheet pile installation on Memorial Drive N.W. between 8 and 9 St N.W.
- Increased noise from the sheet pile will affect the area.
- The biking pathway will be closed between 8 and 9 St. N.W. All pathway users will share the pedestrian pathway.
- Regular construction hours are planned to be 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Parking Impacts:

- There are no significant impacts anticipated to available parking along Memorial Drive N.W.
- Your "L" parking permit can be used to park throughout the entire "L" zone for the duration of construction. A parking zone map can be found at maps.calgary.ca/calgaryparking.

Pathway Impacts:

- During construction, sections of the Bow River Pathway between 14 St N.W. and Centre St will be impacted, detours will be provided.
- Commuter cyclists are encouraged to use the downtown pathway (south side of the Bow River) during construction.


