

Riley Area Construction Projects

Gladstone Connect Construction Schedule Update*

An updated construction schedule for the <u>Gladstone Connect</u> project is outlined below.

Ongoing – October 30

- 4 Ave N.W. closed between 8 St N.W. and 10 St N.W.
- 9A St N.W. closed between 4 Ave N.W. and 3 Ave N.W. (Delivery access will be maintained).
- Sunnyside North LRT crosswalk closed.

Ongoing – October 30

- Intersection of 4 Ave N.W. & 7 St N.W. closed.
- Access to 5 Ave N.W. will be maintained via 4 Ave N.W.

November 11 – November 21

Gladstone Road N.W. closed between 11A St N.W. to 12 St N.W.

November 11 – November 28

- 11 St N.W from Kensington Road N.W. north to the gates will be closed.
- Alley behind Kensington Road N.W. between 10a St N.W. and 11a St. N.W. open for limited local traffic and some parking only.

3 Avenue N.W. Public Realm Improvements

The <u>3 Avenue N.W. Public Realm improvements</u> construction schedule has been updated.

Following feedback from the community and considering the forecasted temperatures, the decision has been made to carry out construction

activities during the day rather than at night, as had been previously stated. **Schedule***

- Work began on October 16 and will continue into November.
- Construction hours: 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Construction Impacts

- Traffic and access to the area will be maintained.
- Residents can expect to see construction trucks entering and leaving the area, construction noise and dust.
