

Riley Area Construction: October 2024 Update

Construction Schedule Updates*

3 Avenue N.W. Public Realm Improvements

Construction of public realm improvements along 3 Avenue N.W. is tentatively scheduled to start on October 15, 2024.

Location: 3 Avenue N.W. between 10 Street N.W. and 9A St N.W.

Duration: October 15 into November

Regular work hours: During night hours from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Construction Impacts:

- Traffic and access to the area will be maintained during daytime hours.
- Residents will see closures and work being completed during nighttime hours.
- Residents can expect to see construction trucks entering and leaving the area, construction noise and dust.

October 15 – October 21, 2024

- 9 St N.W. between 1 Ave N.W. and Memorial Dr N.W. will be closed to remove and replace a manhole.
- 24/7 closure for the duration of the work.
- No street parking on 9 St
 N.W. between 1 Ave N.W. and
 Memorial Dr N.W.
- The 8 St N.W. intersection will be fully re-opened to allow for community access.

Ongoing

 Two EB lanes of Memorial Dr N.W. closed with two-way traffic on WB Memorial Dr N.W. between Centre St and 8 St N.W.

October 7 – October 12

 Pathway closure at Prince's Island Pedestrian Bridge and 7 St N.W. for stormwater utility work.

Ongoing to late October

- Right lane of EB Memorial Dr N.W. between 10 St N.W. and 14 St N.W.
- Daily lane closure should be expected from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Ongoing to late October

 Regional Pathway along Memorial Dr N.W. will be closed between 10 St N.W. and 14 St. N.W.

Pathway and parking impacts:

There are no significant impacts anticipated to available parking along Memorial Dr N.W. During construction, residents will be encouraged to use garages or laneway parking if available.

"L" parking permits can be used to park throughout the entire "L" zone for the duration of construction. A parking zone map can be found here. During construction, sections of the Bow River Pathway between 14 St. N.W. and Centre St. will be impacted. During this time, pathway users will be provided with detours to ensure safety and connectivity. Updated pathway detour information can be found here.

Commuter cyclists will be encouraged to use the downtown pathway (south side of Bow River) during construction.
