



Construction Update: Bearspaw South Feeder Main Repair

September 13, 2024

The City of Calgary is in the final stages of making urgent repairs to sections of the Bearspaw South Feeder Main. The majority of these repairs are taking place along a section of 33 Ave N.W. and along 16 Ave N.W. as well as a section at Shouldice Park.

UPDATE: 33 Ave. N.W.

Our crews are in final stages of construction in backfilling and repaving the road on 33 Avenue N.W.

At worksites 2 and 3 which are located between 78 St N.W. and 83 St N.W., paving is underway and we expect to open the section of 33 Avenue N.W. east of 83rd Street N.W. over the weekend. This will be dependent on weather over the next few days.

We are continuing to work at sites 1 and 5 which are located in the section west of 83 St N.W. This section will reopen next week.

UPDATE: 16 Ave. N.W.

Construction is nearing completion on 16 Avenue N.W. with paving activities taking place over the weekend. We anticipate removing current construction detours and opening 16th Avenue by Monday, September 16th. However, there will be localized lane closures to accommodate bringing the feeder main back into service.

Sidewalk, Curb, and Driveway Restoration

Once our crews finish repaving the road, we will begin restoring sidewalks, curbs, and driveways.

Landscaping Restoration

As landscaping design varies across the neighbourhood, we will be assessing each affected area to determine the appropriate time for restoration. In some cases, certain plants/landscaping may not survive the winter if replanted now. We will discuss with individual homeowners their specific circumstances.

Supporting Montgomery and Bowness Businesses

As this continues to be a challenging time for businesses in the community of Montgomery and Bowness, we are encouraging Calgarians to continue visiting and supporting these businesses over the weekend as we near the final stages in construction.
