



Woodlands Sanitary Lift Station Upgrade

December 2020

The City of Calgary continues to treat, test and deliver high-quality water to Calgarians during the COVID-19 pandemic. While we prioritize the delivery of essential services, our capital construction programs are moving forward where possible. These construction projects are critical to supporting current and future development while also protecting our environment.

As with all capital projects, our priority is the health, safety and well-being of our staff and contractors. We continue to put in place new measures and protocols to ensure public health is always protected.

Background

Woodlands Sanitary Lift Station collects, temporary stores, and pumps wastewater from the community to a wastewater treatment plant.

Built in 1983, the lift station is now more than 30 years old and there are several major components that are in need of replacement.

For this particular lift station, the roof, the HVAC system, standby generator, the electrical system and various control panels are all being replaced. This work will ensure the sanitary lift station operates properly and safely in the future.

The City is working with the contractor, PCL Construction Management Inc. to minimize the construction impact while ensuring the safety of the public and employees during construction.

Construction update

Construction was originally scheduled to be complete by end of 2020 but is now expected to be complete in late February 2021. The extra time is required to coordinate the utilities needed to support the upgraded infrastructure.

Construction impacts

- Regular work hours will be 7 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- We will do our best to minimize construction noise. Most of our construction noise will take place indoors during construction hours.
- There will be a pathway closure with detour signs during construction.
- Contractor vehicles will be parked on street and will not block driveways.
- Construction work will adhere to the Community Standards Bylaw. There is a standby generator on site that will only be used in the event of utility power outage.
- For safety, the work site will be fenced, and access will be restricted to construction personnel only.
