Application for Disposal of Clean Fill at WRS Waste Management Facilities

Clean Fill Definition: Clean fill is natural, unprocessed soil excavated from uncontaminated sites that cannot be reused on-site and must be removed. It includes:

- Naturally occurring clay, silt, sand, gravel, and rocks up to six (6) inches.
- No topsoil (Approx. 2-7 inches of surface soil, per Alberta Soil Conservation Act, Nov 1, 2010).

The following are not classified as Clean Fill:

Customer information is required to apply for a Clean Fill Disposal Permit, to allow access any of the three City of Calgary Waste Management Facilities (WMFs). **Complete Part B of this form.**

Clean Fill Disposal Permit Requirements:

- Soil must be dry and free of oversized foreign materials.
- Soil analytical data is required based on the City WMFs needs.
- Number of samples are determined by the WMF Environmental Control Technologist (ECT).
- Analytical results must be from an accredited laboratory, and less than 12 months old.
- Acceptance criteria are based on CCME and Alberta User Guide for Waste Managers.
- Minimum analytical requirements:

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- Additional analysis may be requested by the ECT.

Additional visual inspections by a City of Calgary ECT may be required before clean fill will be accepted.

Permitted Clean Fill Rate: \$0 to \$10.00 per tonne. Note, soils found with lab exceedances may be considered as Industrial Clean Fill at the \$10.00 per tonne rate. Non-compliant materials will be charged the basic sanitary waste rate at any City WMF.

Exceptions:

- Residents self-hauling do not need a permit if using an unmarked or non-commercial vehicle.
- Soil from a private residence hauled by a commercial hauler may be accepted without analytical info, although **a permit is required**. Provide:
 - Address of origin
 - Clean fill volume
 - Hauling company name
- Exceptions may also be considered on a case-by-case basis.
