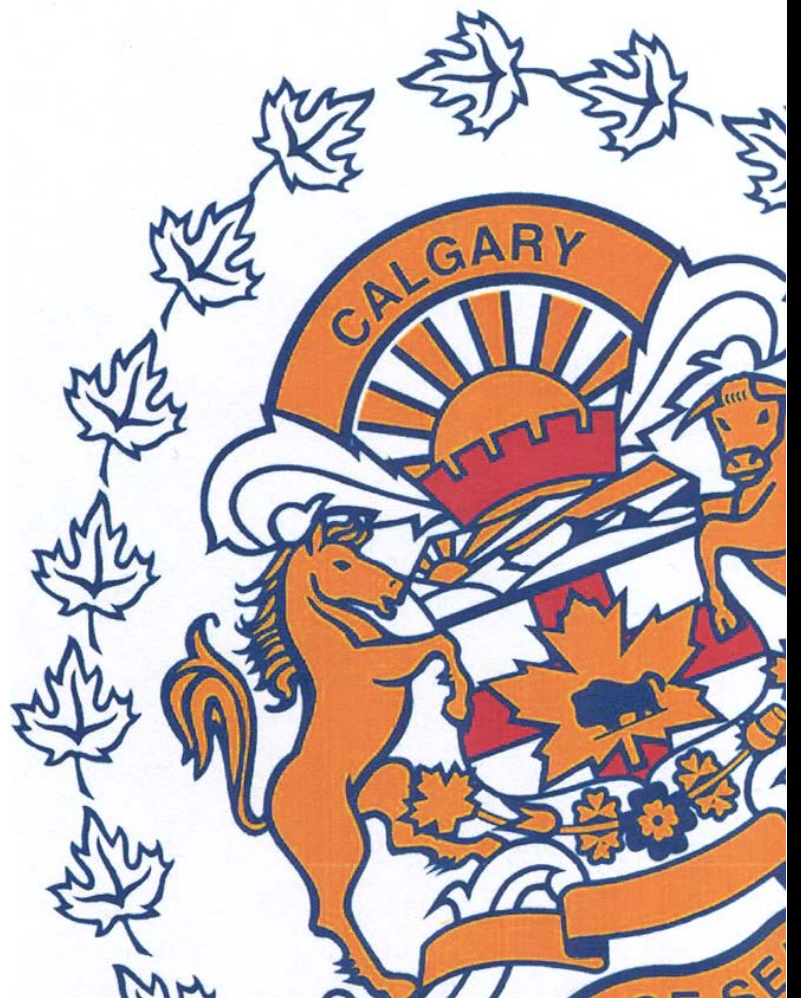

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REPORT NOTES

Most of the statistical data in this report are derived from the Police Information Management System (PIMS) and compiled by the Centralized Analysis Unit. The numbers reported may change on a daily basis due to the dynamic nature of offences being reported and cleared. Disorder data is derived from the CAD system and is static.

To a large extent, the data in this report are based on accumulated to date information. **(Except for the Monthly Highlights which are based on static information (i.e.: a snap-shot in time).**

- For offences based on accumulated to date information, the number of offences recorded may be higher than previously reported (i.e. in previous statistical reports) due to late reporting. Although this does not greatly affect the number of occurrences for all offences, for some categories it may be as high as a 30-40% increase. The published data for the current period can therefore be expected to increase as time passes. As a result, readers should exercise caution when making comparisons between historical data and current data (i.e. previous year to this year) as data for the historic period will now include late reported offences, but data for the current period will not at this time. To achieve an effective comparison, current data should be evaluated against the originally published data for the historic period.
- Likewise, late reporting affects the number and percentage of offences cleared. Cases are often cleared months and sometimes years later. Consequently, clearances for previous years may appear to be much higher than those of the present year. Cases “cleared by charge” and those “cleared otherwise” are included in these totals.
- For offences based on “static” or “snap-shot” information, data totals will only reflect the number of offences reported in the original publication. They are not updated. Although late reporting may occur, and offences may continue to be cleared as time passes, these new events are not taken into account when preparing this statistical report.

A single incident may result in multiple offences, with each unique *Criminal Code* violation within the incident being counted as an offence. Furthermore, person crime offences are typically counted by the number of victims. Please note that offences are assigned to the month in which the offence "started", not the month they were reported or cleared. Also note that “attempted” incidents are included in these totals. Monthly Highlights – STATIC NUMBER COMPARISON

To reduce the impact of late reporting, comments on this page are a comparison between the CPS September 2016 Statistical Report and the CPS September 2015 Statistical Report. To achieve an effective comparison, current data should be evaluated against the originally published data for the historic period.

SEPTEMBER 2016

PERSON CRIME

- ◆ Reported **person crimes** for the month of September 2016 increased slightly, by 2.8% when compared to September 2015 (764 offences in September 2016 vs. 743 in September 2015). Person crimes were also 15.2% above the five year September average.
- ◆ Total **robbery** offences for the month of September 2016 significantly decreased when compared to September 2015; by 42.4% (53 offences in September 2016 vs. 92 in September 2015); During September 2016 there were:
 - 0 **financial robberies** (compared to 2 in September 2015);
 - 17 **commercial robberies** (compared to 38 in September 2015);
 - 36 **person robberies** (compared to 48 in September 2015);and
 - 0 **home invasions** (compared to 4 in September 2015).
- ◆ **Assaults** increased 11.6% when compared to September 2015 (586 offences in September 2016 vs. 525 in September 2015).
- ◆ **Sex offences** increased 14.7% this month (78 offences in September 2016 vs. 68 in September 2015).

PROPERTY CRIME

- ◆ Reported **property crimes** this month increased 6.2% when compared to September 2015 (4702 offences in September 2016 compared to 4427 in September 2015). Property crimes were also 35.8% above the five year September average.
- ◆ **Vehicle theft** (including attempts) increased 19.4% when compared to September 2015 (733 offences in September 2016 vs. 614 in September 2015).
- ◆ **Theft** offences increased 5.7% this month when compared to September 2015 (2422 offences in September 2016 vs. 2292 in September 2015).
- ◆ **Break and enter** offences this month increased by a mild 3.6% when compared to September 2015 (725 offences this month compared to 700 in September 2015).
 - **Residential break and enter** offences this month decreased 12.6% when compared to September 2015 (243 offences in September 2016 vs. 278 in September 2015); and
 - **Commercial break and enter** offences increased 25.3% this month when compared to September 2015 (277 offences in September 2016 vs. 221 in September 2015).
- ◆ **Fraud related** offences increased 58.9% this month (332 offences in September 2016 vs. 209 in September 2015).

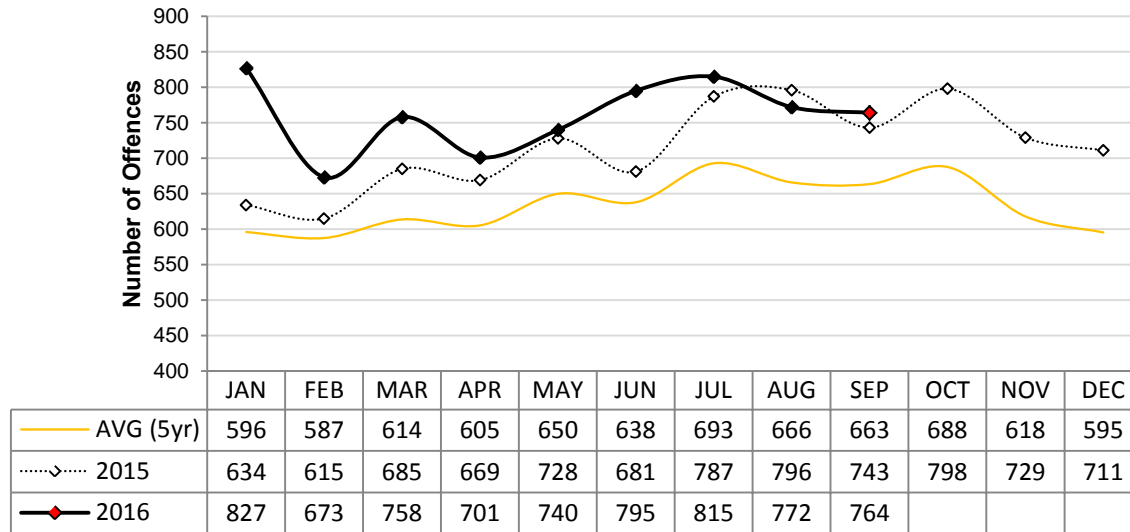
Calgary Person Crime Statistics – STATIC NUMBERS

To achieve an effective comparison, current data should be evaluated against the originally published data for the historic period. *Due to the dynamic nature of ongoing homicide investigations these numbers may have been manually updated to reflect the current homicide count. Due to manually updating, it's possible 1 or more homicides may be reflected within the assault category. The homicide counts are provided by the homicide unit.

YTD Jan 01 to Sep 30 2016**



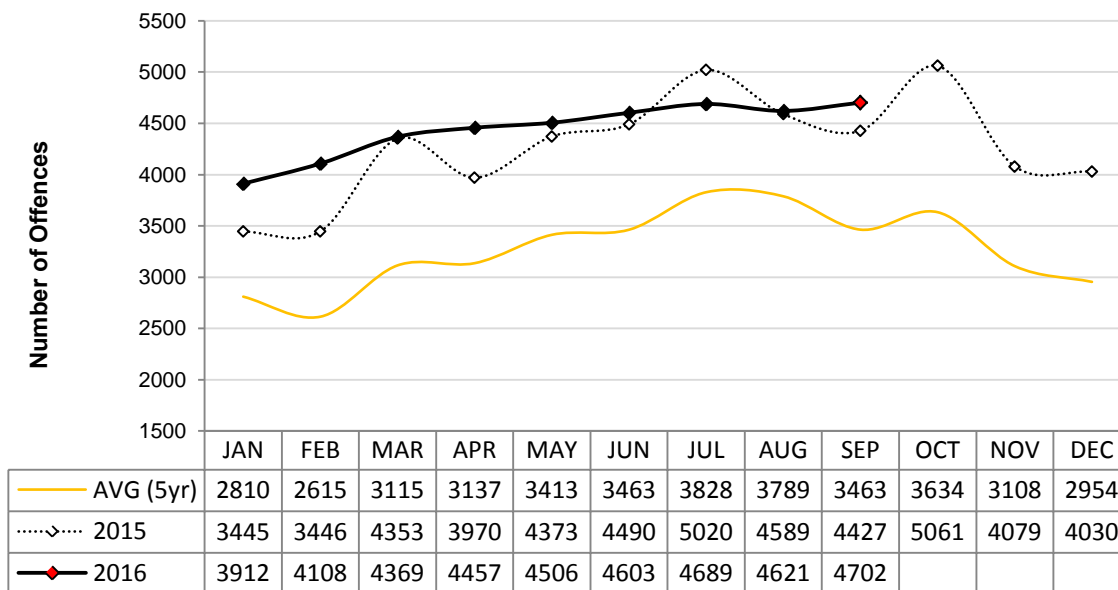

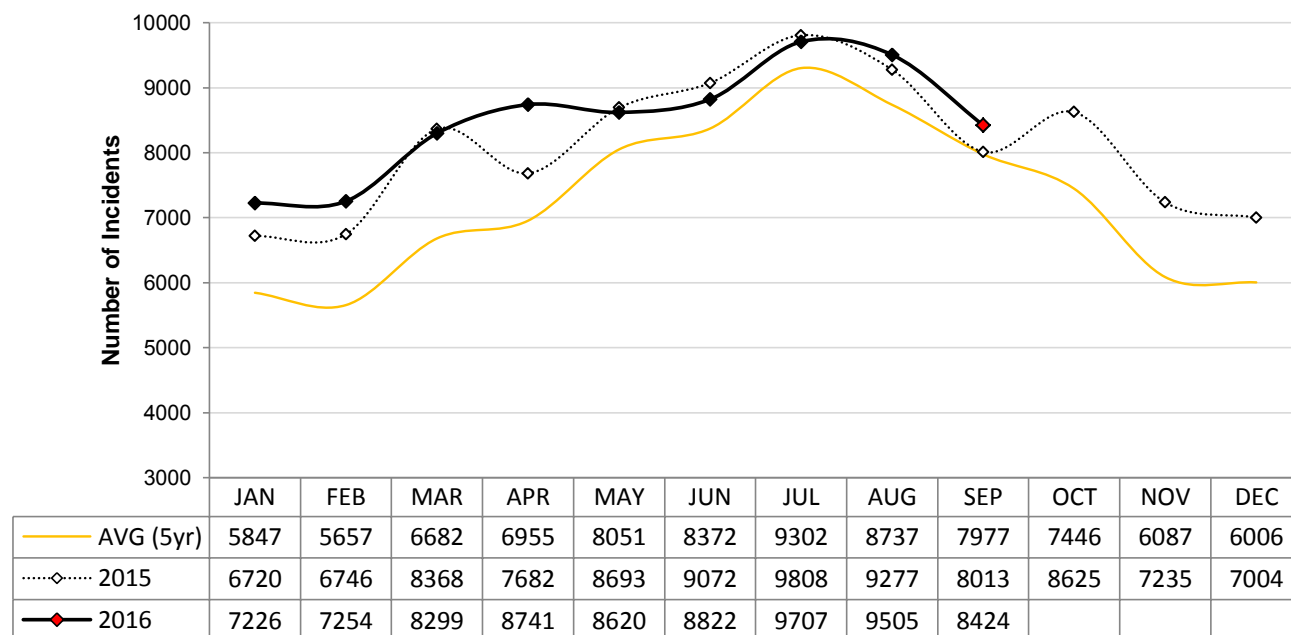
Calgary Disorder Statistics – CALLS FOR SERVICE

In addition to monitoring crime levels, the Calgary Police Service uses a range of incident types to record levels of "Social & Physical Disorder". The incident types selected for this disorder index are those which can have a negative impact on citizens' quality of life and perception of safety, particularly in public places. These incidents do not tend to be represented well in "traditional" crime statistics which have a propensity to focus more on person and property crime.

- 3) *With the introduction of the new CAD system in October 2014, the event types of Juvenile and Prowler expired, however, calls that were previously captured within these event types will likely now be categorized within other disorder event types (e.g. disturbance, etc.).
- 4) **The majority of Property Damage calls result in criminal code reports which are counted under Other Property Crimes in this report. 'Graffiti' calls for service are now captured within Property Damage with the introduction of the new CAD system (whereas previously these calls were recorded outside of the CAD system).
