Do you have a good idea for naming this park or other City space?

Calgarians can suggest names for City spaces, there are just a few things you should know before you submit your idea.

- Names that work the best reflect our heritage, local geographic features, local flora and fauna, and provide a sense of community.
- We also suggest notable Calgarians and former elected representatives at all levels of government. But they should be retired, and we recommend getting their (or their estates) consent.
- We won't consider names that are offensive, misleading or too similar to names used elsewhere in the City.

Does your idea meet these requirements?

Then email your suggestion with the rational explaining the significance of the chosen name to municipal.naming@calgary.ca by October 7, 2019.

What will happen next?

- The suggested names will be reviewed by The City of Calgary.
- The Community Association will be asked to help narrow down the options. They may recommend up to 2 or 3 names for consideration.
- The names will be forwarded to City Council's Priority and Finance Committee for review.
- Then it will go to City Council for final consideration.
